Spending Ideas

Outdoor Play Equipment

The playground situated to the left of the reception is used by KS1 but fails to provide much for the children to play with. We are aiming to create an outdoor space in this area consisting of play equipment for the children that will further evolve as funding becomes available. Outdoor play equipment can be expensive (£5k plus) and we are currently in the process of obtaining quotes. We are also looking to see whether there are any grants that we can apply for to help finance this project as well as building some of the play equipment ourselves.

Outdoor Covered Seating Area

As a result of speaking to the children, we are aware that there is a lack of outdoor seating areas that provide shade so we are looking to create a covered area with picnic benches where the children are able to socialise at lunchtime. This area could also be transformed into an outdoor teaching area when required. Outside teaching areas have proven to be very successful in schools around the UK and can be beneficial to children's wellbeing. With the gardening club becoming more and more popular with the children, this would be an ideal space to accommodate this event. We are also aware that when it rains at drop-off and pick-up time, we can all end up getting a little bit soggy so we also propose to use this area as a much needed shelter for parents.
